

Beer - the Hi5 Hop Head Hierarchy

(KNOWN IN CERTAIN CIRCLES AS 'THE AA 'TO Z CLUB')

THE CHALLENGE: Drink 200 different beers (we have over 250), and we'll reward you with a \$200 Rocky Top Notch dining card, good in any of our restaurants. Plus other free stuff like a t-shirt, a baseball cap, your own personalized mug and your own freakin' stool to encourage you along the way...

All beer is made up of four basic ingredients: water, malted barley, hops and yeast. Varying any or all of these will produce the following:

LAGERS: Lager yeasts need cool temperatures during fermentation to perform their magic. Tend to be lighter in color and usually taste drier than ales.

ALES: Fermented in warmer temperatures for the yeast to multiply and do its magic. Usually higher in alcohol content and noticeably fuller and more complex than lagers.

SPECIALTY BEERS: Ales, lagers or a hybrid of the two that contain other ingredients (herbs, fruits, spices, grains, etc.) that prevent them from being "true" ales or lagers.

Oh, enough with the scientific mumbo-jumbo, bring on the beer...

Lagers

AMSTEL LIGHT (HOLLAND) \$4.50

The beer drinker's light beer...not to be confused with the light beer drinker's beer or the drink drinker's beer light.

BECK'S (GERMANY) \$4.50 German for beer—also, why you failed German.

BROOKLYN LAGER (BROOKLYN, NY) \$4.50 Their flagship freakin' beer—brewed freakin' Vienna-style, before it was hip. Forget about it.

BUDWEISER (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 The King of Bieres.

BUD LIGHT (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 If you've never tried this beer, we need to see some I.D.

BUD SELECT (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 Never the last one picked in dodgeball.

COORS LIGHT - (GOLDEN, CO) \$3.50 Just opening one of these puts Wake County schools on a two hour delay.

CORONA - (MEXICO) \$4.50 The true beer Connessieur will detect subtle hints of lime...and spring break!

CORONA LIGHT (MEXICO) \$4.50 Diet limes available upon request.

DOS EQUIS (MEXICO) \$4.50 After a few too many, 2 X's do mark the spot.

FLYING DOG OLD SCRATCH (DENVER, CO) \$4.50 Fermented at medium temperatures to develop both ale and lager characteristics. A trophy case full of gold medals hangs around this old dog's collar.

GROLSCH (HOLLAND) \$4.50 Say it, don't spray it.

HARP (IRELAND) \$4.00 Sorta cool, but doesn't get you laid like the guitar.

HEINEKEN (HOLLAND) \$4.50 Nothing says old school hip hop dance party like this selection from the land of windmills and wooden shoes.

HEINEKEN PREMIUM LIGHT (HOLLAND) \$4.50 Dear Chubb Rock, Heavy D and The Fat Boys, you bring the reunion tour, we've got the sponsor.

IRON CITY (PITTSBURGH, PA) \$3.50 The Steelers rode the bus to Super Bowl XL. This was on the bus.

KONA LONGBOARD (HAWAII) \$5.50 Grab the ukulele, there's gonna be a luau!

LABATT'S (CANADA) \$3.50 Good enough for the Great One, good enough for us.

MICHELOB LIGHT (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 Official beer of the PGA Tour and 99.5% of John Daly.

MICHELOB ULTRA LIME CACTUS (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 You might want to use a koozie when drinking this beer.

MICHELOB ULTRA AMBER (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 Ultra's hot little half-sister, with a better tan.

MGD (MILWAUKEE, WI) \$3.50 The "M" stands for Miller. You'll understand the "GD" part in the morning.

MGD 64 (MILWAUKEE, WI) \$3.50 Leave it to the land of cheese to come up with a 64 calorie beer.

MILLER LITE (MILWAUKEE, WI) \$3.50 Never won any spelling bees.

MILLER HIGH LIFE (MILWAUKEE, WI) \$3.50 The Champagne of Beers (we offer the 40 oz. version complimentary to newlyweds, royalty and heads of state).

MOLSEN CANADIAN (CANADA) \$3.50 Canada's heartfelt apology for Celine Dion and that "Sk8er Boi" song. Thanks alot, Canada.

MOLSEN GOLDEN (CANADA) \$3.50 You could shower in this beer and your buddies would refer to it as a...

MOOSEHEAD (CANADA) \$3.50 Back at the lodge, in your funny hat, this really hits the spot, eh?

NEGRA MODELO (MEXICO) \$4.50 Sweet creamy flavor with a slightly chocolate aftertaste. Lou Dobbs—not a fan.

O'DOULS AMBER (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.50 If the bartender offers you one of these, you're either pregnant or it's time to go.

PACIFICO (MEXICO) \$4.50 Way bigger than the Atlantico.

PAULANER ORIGINAL (GERMANY) \$4.50 Extremely clean and crisp. What a pale lager should be.

PBR (MILWAUKEE, WI) \$2.00 Loot at you, rock star/homeless person.

PERONI (ITALY) \$4.50 The Ferrari of Lagers... but hairy guys from Jersey who drive Pontiac Firebirds and wear a lot of gold seem to really enjoy it as well.

RED STRIPE (JAMAICA) \$4.50 Beer + No Woman = No Cry

ROLLING ROCK (LATROBE, PA) \$3.50 The fine people at the Latrobe Brewing Company ask that you please NOT lay off the rock.

SAM ADAMS (BOSTON, MA) \$4.50 The best beer we have made by men in wigs.

SAM ADAMS LIGHT (BOSTON, MA) \$4.50 Skinny men in wigs.

SOL (MEXICO) \$4.50 Like Corona, but more of a loner.

STARR HILL JOMO (CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA) \$4.50 Caramel malts on the front, finishes nicely balanced and relatively clean with slight hopiness. This can be considered one of the only things defined as balanced and clean from Charlottesville, VA.

STELLA ARTOIS (BELGIUM) \$4.50 Excellent selection for those desperately seeking to get their groove back.

TECATE (MEXICO) \$3.50 Tequila, Tecate. Tomato, Tamale.

XINGU (BRAZIL) \$4.50 A rare style of lager traditionally brewed in South America, its black opaqueness comes from its dark roast malts grown in the Amazon...and fun say.

YEUNGLING (POTTSVILLE, PA) \$3.50 Born on dating? This is America's oldest brewery.

YEUNGLING LIGHT (POTTSVILLE, PA) \$3.50 179 year old beer on a diet, now that's dedication. Let's see what kind of shape you're in when you're 179.

Pilsners/Kölsch Style

(Pale Lagers)

Pilsner style beer originated in Pilzen, Czechoslovakia in 1842. Today's Pilsners have a good amount of carbonation and are clean and crisp.



BIG BOSS ANGRY ANGEL (RALEIGH, NC) \$4.50

Refreshingly pale German-style ale...so why you so angry, Angel?

CARLSBERG (DENMARK) \$4.00 After being trampled by 100,000 screaming futbol fans, this really hits the spot.

FLYING DOG TIRE BITE (DENVER, CO) \$4.50 This Kölsch-style ale is light and refreshing with a flavorful hop edge. The artist for the brewery's labels also illustrated for Hunter S. Thompson.

GAFFEL KÖLSCH (GERMANY) \$5.50 Brewed in accordance with the German Purity Law of 1516. So there.

JEVER PILSENER (GERMANY) \$4.50 More hop aroma than your average pils. More popular than David Hasselhoff.

LEFT HAND POLESTAR PILSNER (LONGMONT, CO) \$4.50 A zesty, German-style pilsner that doesn't discriminate, lefty or righty.


NORTH COAST SCRIMSHAW (FORT BRAGG, CA) \$4.50 Drink the Scrimshaw, ride the rickshaw.

PILSNER URQUELL (CZECH REPUBLIC) \$4.50 Remember that show "Family Matters"? Yeah, that show sucked.

ST. PAULI GIRL (GERMANY) \$4.00 Pauli was a saint? Really? Have you seen the rack on this chick?!

VICTORY PRIMA PILS (DOWNINGTON, PA) \$4.50 Not to be taken in combination with any other pils.

MASH HOUSE IPA \$4.00/\$15.00 Our signature beer and a favorite of our team. Our IPA is a true copper color and big in hop bitterness, flavor and aroma. Silver Medal Winner in the 2001 Great American Beer Festival.

BUD LIGHT (ST. LOUIS, MO) \$3.25/\$14.00 We could almost leave the tap handle open, without losing a drop.

FAT TIRE AMBER (FORT COLLINS, CO) \$5.00/\$20.00 The best beer in America brewed by wind. No seriously, New Belgium is the first wind powered brewery in America.

GUINNESS (IRELAND) \$6.00/\$24.00 A Black n'Tan, Black n'Blue, Black n'More Black, its up to you.

SWEETWATER 420 PALE ALE (ATLANTA, GA) \$6.00/\$24.00 Dude, I've got the munchies, pass the Doritos.

Ales - Ambers & Reds

A style without definition. The difference between pale and amber ales is darker "caramel" malt character and less assertive hops.

ABITA AMBER (ABITA SPRINGS, LA) \$4.50 Listed frequently in the recipes of New Orleans Chefs. Step one: boil crawfish. Step two: drink beer.

ANCHOR STEAM (SAN FRANCISCO, CA) \$5.50 Remember Uncle Jesse, Uncle Joey, and Danny Tanner from "Full House?" They were just roommates.

BASS ALE (ENGLAND) \$4.50 The first "Black n' Tan" was poured in 1889. Where were you?

BELL'S AMBER ALE (COMSTOCK, MI) \$5.50 Their flagship beer is an excellent example of this style when its done exactly right.

BLACK DOG ALE (BOZEMAN, MO) \$4.00 The beer will be your companion, best friend, and won't pee on your carpet.

DOS EQUIS AMBER (MEXICO) \$4.50 Amber from the Montezuma Brewery in Mexico. The name translates to "2X's" referring to the celebration of the turn of the last century. Party like it's 1899.

 **DUCK RABBIT AMBER (FARMVILLE, NC) \$4.50** This Tar Heel Brewery emphasizes malt complexity with layered caramel malts and blatant cross-breeding.

 **HIGHLAND GAELIC (ASHEVILLE, NC) \$4.50** This rich amber ale from our friends in the mountains is exceptionally balanced between malty sweetness and delicate hop bitterness. Pairs well with hiking, hackysack, Ultimate Frisbee and a dog sporting a bandana.

KILLIAN'S IRISH RED (GOLDEN, CO) \$3.50 The quintessential Irish Red, from the sweet, sweet Motherland...Colorado.

LOST COAST ALLEY CAT AMBER (EUREKA, CA) \$4.50 A great amber that goes well with pizza, and who doesn't love pizza?!

LEINENKUGEL AMBER (CHIPPEWA FALLS, WI) \$4.50 This beer got its start quenching the thirst of 19th century lumberjacks. Emulating Paul Bunyan and the Brawny guy has never been so cool and refreshing.

NORTH COAST RED SEAL (FORT BRAGG, CA) \$4.50 This full-bodied, copper-red ale is generously hopped for a long, spicy finish. Made with 100% pure, unfiltered baby red seals.

SHINER BOCK (SHINER, TX) \$4.00 The smartest thing to come out of Texas in at least 8 years.

SMITHWICK'S (IRELAND) \$4.50 An Irish Red from the makers of Guinness. Magically delicious.

Ales - Dark Browns & Porters

Often confused with stouts, these are medium-bodied beers that owe their color and flavor to black or chocolate (but not roasted) malts.

 **BIG BOSS BAD PENNY (RALEIGH, NC) \$4.50** Brewed just a few blocks away from Hi5. Unlike its name sake, this beer is welcome back time and time again.

BROOKLYN BROWN (BROOKLYN, NY) \$4.50 American-style nut brown ale. Deep mahogany color with a long-lasting tan head. Rich malty flavor from sip to swallow. NO SLEEP 'TIL...

 **CAROLINA NUT BROWN (HOLLY SPRINGS, NC) \$4.00** Medium-bodied, dark brown ale with a complex chocolate malty taste. A very respectable citrus hop backbone does its job quietly.

 **DUCK RABBIT PORTER (FARMVILLE, NC) \$4.50** Oats are added to provide a subtle, round silkiness to the mouthfeel. Sounds a little dirty, but the taste is exceptional.

FLYING DOG ROAD DOG (DENVER, CO) \$4.50 Dark and rich like Billy Dee. Peculiarly fruity like Prince..

HE'BREW MESSIAH BOLD (SAN FRANCISCO, CA) \$4.50 The Chosen Beer. Its says it right on the label.

LEFT HAND BLACK JACK PORTER (LONGMONT, CO) \$4.50 A safe bet. Pays 3:2)

NEWCASTLE BROWN ALE (ENGLAND) \$4.50 A handsome ruby red like Aunt Diane, nutty like Uncle Joe.

ROGUE MOCHA PORTER (NEWPORT, OR) \$5.75 This dark brown ale is slightly hoppy with hints of chocolate and coffee. Brewed with coastal free-range water. Yep, free-range water.

WYCHWOOD HOBGOBLIN (ENGLAND) \$5.75 Known for its ruby red, full-bodied chocolate toffee malt flavor with rounded moderate bitterness and an overall fruity character. Make sure your parents check it for razorblades.

Ales - Stouts

Roasted malts define this classically Irish style of beer.

ABITA TURBODOG (ABITA SPRINGS, LA) \$4.50 Extremely dark ale-Also, why the Falcons won't make the playoffs again this year.

AVERY OUT OF BOUNDS STOUT (BOULDER, CO) \$5.50 One in, two out, hitting three.

BELL'S KALAMAZOO STOUT (COMSTOCK, MI) \$5.00 A full-bodied stout with plenty of roast flavor. From Timbuktu to... your mouth.

BISON ORGANIC CHOCOLATE STOUT (BERKELEY, CA) \$5.50 100% organic, meaning real cocoa powder is added to the mash, and absolutely no bison were harmed in the making of this beer.

 **DUCK RABBIT MILK STOUT (FARMVILLE, NC) \$4.50** Traditional stout brewed with lactose (milk sugar). Highly roasted grains give this beer its depth.

 **HIGHLAND BLACK MOCHA STOUT (ASHEVILLE, NC) \$4.50** A very malty body and large roasted chocolate flavor, its Highland's most robust beer.

LION STOUT (SRI LANKA) \$4.50 All ingredients are transported along precarious roads to the brewery located 3500 feet above sea level.

LEFT HAND MILK STOUT (LONGMONT, CO) \$5.50 2006 World Beer Cup Gold Medal Winner in the "Sweet Stout" category. Strong roasted malt and coffee flavors build the foundation of this classic cream stout, while the addition of mild sugar mellows the intense roastiness. Righty or Lefty, this beer is amphibious.

NEW HOLLAND "THE POET" OATMEAL STOUT (HOLLAND, MI) \$5.50 This beer has a rich, smooth malt character enveloped in tones of roast chocolate. A soft mouth-feel brings luxurious flavors and a smoothing aroma...and you don't even know it.

STARR HILL DARK STARR STOUT (CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA) \$4.50 Brewed with roasted barley and hints of coffee and dark chocolate, it packs a robust taste into a surprisingly light body.

Ales - IPA

India Pale Ale gets its name and unique style from British brewers who were making beer for export to India. The style has intense hop flavor which was used to preserve the beer for the long voyage.

EVERY IPA (BOULDER, CO) \$5.50 Brewed by hopheads for hopheads. Demands to be poured into a glass to truly appreciate the citrusy, floral bouquet and the rich, malty finish. Hear that? It said, "Pour me in a glass!" 6.3% ABV

BELL'S TWO HEARTED ALE (COMSTOCK, MI) \$5.50 American malts and enormous hop additions give this beer a crisp finish and incredible floral hop aroma. Remember those Siamese twins on "Springer" where one wanted to be a country singer and the other...never mind. 7.0% ABV

 **CAROLINA IPA (HOLLY SPRINGS, NC) \$4.00** Finished with cascade hops to give it a fresh, "green" aftertaste. Searsuckers, Rainbows and Croakies not required, but, hey, you're already wearing them. 5.4% ABV

DOG FISH 60-MINUTE IPA (MILTON, DE) \$5.50 "THE SESSION BEER FOR GEEKS." will be seen immediately following the conclusion of today's game, except on the West coast, where it will be seen at its regularly scheduled time. 6.0% ABV

FLYING DOG SNAKE DOG (DENVER, CO) \$4.50 Light in color, hoppy in character, ugly as sin.

GREAT DIVIDE TITAN IPA (DENVER, CO) \$5.50 Some IPA's smack your lips with hop bitterness. This one punches you straight in the grill. 6.8% ABV

HARPOON IPA (WINDSOR, VT) \$4.50 Copper colored, medium-bodied and floral in aroma. Slays giants. 5.9% ABV

 **HIGHLAND KASHMIR (ASHEVILLE, NC) \$4.50** Bold and dry with an aggressive hop finish. Well, aggressive for a bunch of Asheville peace-pipe-smoking granolas. 5.6% ABV

MAD RIVER STEELHEAD DIPA (BLUE LAKE, CA) \$5.50 Not sure what this river's problem is, but this double IPA will knock you on your keister. 8.6% ABV

MAGIC HAT LUCKY KAT (BURLINGTON, VT) \$4.50 Here kitty, kitty...if you're into bitters, you'll love this beer. If you like magic, go back to the sixth grade.

MENDOCINO WHITE HAWK SELECT IPA (MENDOCINO, CA) \$4.00 A blend of West Coast Cascade and English Fuggles combine for an aromatic character that hop-heads will LOVE. 7.0% ABV

NEW HOLLAND MAD HATTER (HOLLAND, MI) \$5.50 Alice approved. Cooper and Wonderland. 5.8% ABV

NORTH COAST ACME (FORT BRAGG, CA) \$4.50 Acme: makers of great rocket skates, anvils, dynamite and now India Pale Ale. 7.1% ABV

VICTORY HOP DEVIL (DOWNINGTON, PA) \$4.50 Menacingly delicious, with the powerful, aromatic punch of whole flower American hops backed up by rich, German malts. Not for losers. 6.7% ABV

Ales - Pale Ales

A style of beer defined by the light (usually American) hops used in the brewing process which typically gives a beer high bitterness and aroma.

ANCHOR LIBERTY (SAN FRANCISCO, CA) \$5.50 Natural "banging" provide the freedom for the champagne-like bubbles.

 **BIG BOSS HELL'S BELLE (RALEIGH, NC) \$4.50** This deceptively strong Belgian blonde is light and refreshing with a citrus and spice finish. "You're only young, but you're gonna die." 7.0% ABV

BODDINGTON'S PUB ALE (ENGLAND) \$5.50 Bottled in a 16oz. nitro-can, this is as approachable as any ESB you'll find.

 **CAROLINA BLONDE (HOLLY SPRINGS, NC) \$3.50** Unlike its namesake, an ale this good is few and far between.


 **CAROLINA PALE ALE (HOLLY SPRINGS, NC) \$4.00** Remember back when we said Searsuckers, Rainbows and Croakies were not required? Well, now they are.

FLYING DOG DOGGIE STYLE (DENVER, CO) \$4.50 Enjoy it, but don't get the wrong idea.

GENESSEE CREAM ALE (ROCHESTER, NY) \$3.50 Half of Rochester's population was conceived thanks to this beer.

GREAT DIVIDE DENVER PALE ALE (DENVER, CO) \$5.50 Fresh or "wet" hops are over-ripened to the brewery the day of their harvest, providing a fruity, juicy, citrusy and grassy (the kind you mow, not smoke) flavor.

HE'BREW GENESIS ALE (SAN FRANCISCO, CA) \$4.50 A Rabbi, a Priest, and a Minister walk into a bar. The bartender says, "What is this, a joke?" Nobody laughs, the Rabbi orders one of these.

 **HIGHLAND ST. THERESE (ASHEVILLE, NC) \$4.50** A golden ale with a slightly malty body balanced by an assertive American hop character and delicate hop aroma. She goes down easy. Makes that St. Pauli Girl chick look like a saint.

KONA FIRE ROCK (HAWAII) \$5.50 If it erupts when you open it, RUN!

MAGIC HAT #9 (BURLINGTON, VT) \$4.50 "What's not to like about Vermont, men and Magic? ...Ben, Jerry, Siegfred, and Roy.

MENDOCINO BLUE HERON PALE ALE (MENDOCINO, CA) \$4.00 Bottle-conditioned, medium-bodied with a crisp, hoppy finish owed primarily to their own special proprietary yeast strain. Known to choke on prey that is too large.

ROGUE DEADGUY (NEWPORT, OR) \$5.75 The logo was created to celebrate the Mayan holiday "The Day of the Dead." It is an ale in the "maibock" style, just a lighter version, like when you're dead.

SIERRA NEVADA PALE ALE (CHICO, CA) \$4.50 Just like you remember it when you were on tour with Phish.

STARR HILL (CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA) \$4.50 Creating a fresh spin on the English Pale Ale tradition, while also creating a fresh spin on the spelling of the word "star"

Wheat Beers

A style first introduced by the Belgians, wheat (along with specialty yeasts) can add flavors to ales ranging from citrus to berry to banana to bubble gum, yep, bubble gum.

ABITA PURPLE HAZE (ABITA SPRINGS, LA) \$4.50 An unfiltered raspberry wheat. Special sugar produced at the brewery offers subtle sweetness that compliments fresh raspberry puree.

ALLAGASH WHITE (PORTLAND, ME) \$6.25 Named after the river and region in Maine where it's produced. A Belgian-style white that truly stands up to its European counterparts.

EVERY WHITE RASCAL (BOULDER, CO) \$5.50 Authentic Belgian white cleverly spiced with coriander and Curacao orange-peel.

BLUE MOON (GOLDEN, CO) \$4.50 Real super-sleuths will be able to direct subtle hints of orange.

FLYING DOG IN-HEAT WHEAT (DENVER, CO) \$4.50 A German-style Hefe that taunts and teases.

HARPOON UFO (WINDSOR, VT) \$4.50 Harpoon's UnFiltered Offering. A lemon wedge is suggested, but that sounds like alien-talk.

 **HIGHLAND PEAK WHEAT (ASHEVILLE, NC) \$4.50** Once you reach the top of the mountain, this is what everyone is drinking.

HOEGAARDEN (BELGIUM) \$4.50 Tradition states that the first Hoegaarden of the day must be finished in three gulps. Maybe that's why the brewery burned down in 1985.

LEFT HAND HAYSTACK WHEAT (LONGMONT, CO) \$4.50 Classic Bavarian-style Hefeweizen with some Belgian White undertones from a brewery that could have just as easily been named "The Stranger."

LEINENKUGEL'S SUNSET WHEAT (CHIPPEWA FALLS, WI) \$4.50 If you're trying to get your girl into beer, this one has all the character of a bowl of Fruity Pebbles.

LOST COAST GREAT WHITE (EUREKA, CA) \$4.50 A tasty American version of the Belgian style with citrus, coriander and a secret blend of herbs. Adult swim for the next 15 minutes.

MAGIC HAT CIRCUS BOY (BURLINGTON, VT) \$4.50 A perfect blend of graceful lemon zest balanced with grainy wheat flour. The human canon ball gets a lot easier after a few of these.

NORTH COAST BLUE STAR (FORT BRAGG, CA) \$4.50 This unfiltered beer is light, fruity and refreshing while very mildly hopped. A great, not too sweet wheat offering. You're my boy, beer.

PAULANER HEFE (GERMANY) \$4.50 If you knew nothing about beer and yeast, you'd swear there was a banana in it. There's not.

FOSTER'S OIL CAN (AUSTRALIA) \$6.25 Australian for beer, but who really speaks Australian anymore? 5.0% ABV 25.4oz

PINKUS ORGANIC UR PILS (GERMANY) \$9.00 This organic pilsner is light to medium body, dry and well-balanced with clean hop and malt character. 5.2% ABV 16.9oz
